- On Wednesday, October 15th, all 10th graders at Crescent Valley and Corvallis High Schools will be taking the PSAT. They are required to do so by state law.
- As we are only able to offer the PSAT once during the year, any junior who wants to take the PSAT must do so on this day as well.
- Testing will take place from 7:45 – 11:30 a.m. at CV on that day for all 10th graders and any interested 11th graders.
- 9th graders will spend 7:45 – 11:30 a.m. participating in activities offered by our Link Crew Leaders and Career Learning team, and they will attend a presentation by a guest speaker.
- 12th graders will spend 7:45 – 11:30 a.m. participating in a **Personal Finance Fair** presented by brass Media Inc. 11th graders who choose not to take the PSAT, will be required to attend the Personal Finance Fair instead
- We will have a modified schedule for the remainder of the day. It will be an “All” meet with 17 minute periods and 40 minute blocks. Students who take classes at CHS do not need to attend class on this day.
