Leukemia is a cancer of the bone marrow and blood and leads to an uncontrollable accumulation of blood cells. This disease has many symptoms some of which include: slow healing of cuts, reduced white cell count, and excessive bleeding. Treatment is usually begun with chemotherapy, which can make patients very sick. Leukemia will cause the deaths of an estimated 52,000 people in the United States. This means that every ten minutes, another child or adult is expected to die from leukemia. With an estimated diagnosis count of 138,000 for next year, this disease is becoming more predominant in society. Pennies for Patients is a fundraiser to help families and patients through the difficult times of treatment and the expenses of medical care.

As an advisor class, we would like you to set a goal to help raise money to combat this virulent disease. For example, *you could have every student in the class donate a dollar. You could ask them to donate the cost of a latte or fast food lunch!*
