

WHAT IS SCRIP?

Scrip is a program run by the Mountain View PTA to help raise funds for school activities. Scrip is the same gift cards, prepaid cards and gift certificates you use at all your favorite stores--only you purchase them through the Mountain View PTA.



For every card or certificate you buy, **Mountain View Elementary gets a percentage from the store.** So you're spending money at normal places like Richey's, Safeway, Fred Meyer, Bi-Mart, Home Depot, Burger King, Blockbuster and many, many other businesses...**but the Mountain View PTA gets a donation from that retailer.**

The best thing about Scrip is it doesn't cost you anything extra. You don't have to buy candy bars, gift wrap or cookie dough. There is no selling, no boxes of goods, no catalogs to carry around. All you have to do is shop at the same stores you already shop at--just buy your "spending money" in advance with us.

And, most importantly, retailers donate from 2-50% of your purchases to our school



MOUNTAIN VIEW PTA SCRIP PROGRAM POLICIES, ENROLLMENT AND WAIVER FORM

1. Each family will be provided a unique **FAMILY ACCOUNT**. In order to participate in the Scrip program please be sure to fill out an Enrollment Form to obtain your Family Account.
2. All Scrip Orders must be accompanied by a check or money order made payable to Mountain View PTA Scrip. Please do not drop cash in the Scrip Order Drop Box. Cash will be accepted at Scrip Table only. Scrip certificate payments are not tax deductible because you receive dollar for dollar value.
3. **ALL SCRIP ORDERS MUST BE PREPAID. NO ORDER WILL BE PLACED UNTIL FULL PAYMENT IS RECEIVED.**
4. If your check is returned because of non-sufficient funds (NSF), you will be charged a \$25 fee payable to Mountain View PTA Scrip. After two NSF checks are tendered on your account, your scrip ordering privileges will be limited to money orders or cash only.
5. Scrip certificates are purchased on your behalf, and are not returnable.
6. When you pickup your scrip certificates, open your order immediately and verify its accuracy. Your signature on the Weekly Order Pickup List indicates you have received your order in its entirety. In the unlikely event you should find a discrepancy in your scrip order, please contact the Mountain View Scrip Program coordinator (Amy Berry at 745-3924 or berryland4@msn.com within 3 days).
7. Scrip certificates are the same as cash, and should be handled accordingly. Mountain View PTA will not be responsible for certificates that are lost, stolen or misplaced while in your possession.
8. Please note that the Scrip certificates will NOT be sent home with the children so as to not place children at risk.
9. You must sign this WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY form in order to enroll into the program. These forms will be kept on file, and Mountain View PTA accepts no responsibility for certificates once they are delivered.
10. Mountain View PTA will be able to provide a summary of each participating family's purchases and the contributions from this account that have gone towards supporting your child / children's school. **Help support our school!**

12. Order forms can be downloaded from the website above, filled out, then dropped off at the PTA Scrip Box next to the school library for your convenience. Please drop checks only, no cash in the Scrip Box.
