Officers' Reports

Treasurer ó classroom allocations made as usual; 2 PTA board members went to PTA conference, PTA agreed to and acquired new playground equipment (balls, hula hoops and other outdoor toys). A new basketball hoop, net and ball pump were purchased with leftover money. Overview of balances: \$130.50 income from eSCRIP, \$33 from t-shirts, \$173.21 at Papa's Pizza. Current bank account balance for Mt. View PTA = \$10,624.86. Current bank account balance for SCRIP = \$3,411.31.

SCRIP ó action item - follow up with co-op to find out how Mt. View can be a part of their giving program

President ó 2 positions still open (President-elect and VP Communications/Volunteers), 5 positions filled, all nominations are coming from the floor. Teacher appreciation - 1st week of May

VP, Volunteers/Communications – Picateers is going great so far; proposal to use Picateers for Fall pictures and also to have a family photo night to raise more money.

VP, Community Building ó quick run-through of events for the rest of the school year; discussion re spaghetti feed, decision to discuss it next year;

Principal ó artist-in-residence update, will have an assembly on Wed April 29th at 2 pm-to have the kids demonstrate what they have done; suggested having a plaque to commemorate each year's artist; decision to put students' thank you notes (for the playground equipment) in the hallway by the cafeteria; will review how the playground equip procedure is working in June; overview of technology needs/goals for school year 2009-2010; overview of overall needs for the school and estimated costs where available for the school year 2009-2010.

Unfinished business - no new business to report

Budget Committee - currently consists of 4 people (Kristin Edel, Paul Schlegelman, Cindy Forney, & Shayna Hicks)- 3 of whom are on PTA board; need 1 more person; Lynne Killion volunteered; proposal made to get current board members and new board members together to discuss next year's events. Budget will be presented at next PTA meeting.

Teacher submission - 4th grade needs additional books to meet the needs of TAG and advanced readers; would like PTA to help pay for the books; discussion and proposal to create a special project fund for the classrooms or increase the allocation per classroom (currently at \$100), PTA will not reimburse teacher for special books but will discuss increasing the classroom allocation.
