5. PSAT, October 15th – Specifics for Sophomores

- ORS (Oregon Revised Statute) 329.488 requires the Department of Education to select a contractor to provide a nationally-normed test that will give 10th graders information about college readiness and advanced course work. Districts are required to offer the test to all sophomores enrolled in public schools in Oregon. There is no make-up opportunity for students who miss taking the test and there is no penalty for lack of participation.
- All Oregon high schools are required to offer 10th grade students an opportunity to take a test that will provide students, teachers and parents with information about the student’s readiness for college or advanced coursework, possible career options, and major fields of study to consider.
- The purpose of the test is to provide the following
 - Predict the success of students on college entrance exams
 - Identify students with high potential to excel in advanced placement (AP) or other honors course
 - Provide each student taking the assessment a career assessment and online exploration of colleges and career opportunities
- Each student who participates will receive access to MyRoad™, a premier major, career and college online advising tool and My College QuickStart™, a web-based college and career planning kit.
