These are things you should be thinking of..

- Order college pamphlet(s)/admission application(s)
- Create/Maintain a file system with each folder holding a separate college. Keep important dates on the front of the folder.
- Schedule campus visit (meal, attend class, tour, if participating in sports: meet coach)
- Transcript request form (see Student Records or download from counseling website** under “Order Transcripts”)
- FAFSA (close as possible to January 1st) www.fafsa.gov
- CSS Profile (if needed, usually only for private colleges/universities) <http://profileonline.collegeboard.com/>
- Scholarship Packet** (Download from counseling website under “Scholarship Packet”)
- IF playing college sports:NCAA registered? NO earlier than July 1st of preceding Senior year) www.ncaaclearinghouse.net
- From the Career Center check out, “The College Handbook,” for admission dates, SAT ranges, costs, etc. “Ruggs’s Recommendations for Colleges,” for selective quality majors at quality colleges.
