The District closely monitors enrollment trends in order to make our projections as accurate as possible. Enrollment has a very direct effect on revenues under the state formula and the district's budget.

**Highlights of the report:**

- \* Overall enrollment decline is expected to continue at the high school level.
- \* There were 10 fewer births in Benton County in 2003 than 2002. Children born in 2003 will enter kindergarten in 2008 or in 2009.
- \* The number of home schooling students in Corvallis has ranged from 226 to 240 since 2001.
- \* Private school enrollment as a percentage of 509J enrollment has ranged from 10.2% to 10.9% since 2003-04.
- \*\* ODE changed the 2005-06 "final" ADMw of 7,690.8 in March, 2008. This affects the 2006-07 final adjustment in May, 2008.
- \* ADMr is the Average Daily Membership for enrolled students, with kindergartners counting as one-half. Final ADMr is projected to be about 98% of the September 30th enrollment projection.
- \* ADMw is Average Daily Membership weighted with such factors as English-as-a-Second Language and IEP students.
- \* Extended ADMw is the greater of the prior year's ADMw or the current year's ADMw. In 2008-09, we expect funding on the current year, rather than the prior year.
