

Getting and Installing IrfanView

IrfanView is free photo editing software for noncommercial use. It is available at <http://www.irfanview.com/>

Click on Download in the left margin. Click on the top Tucows.

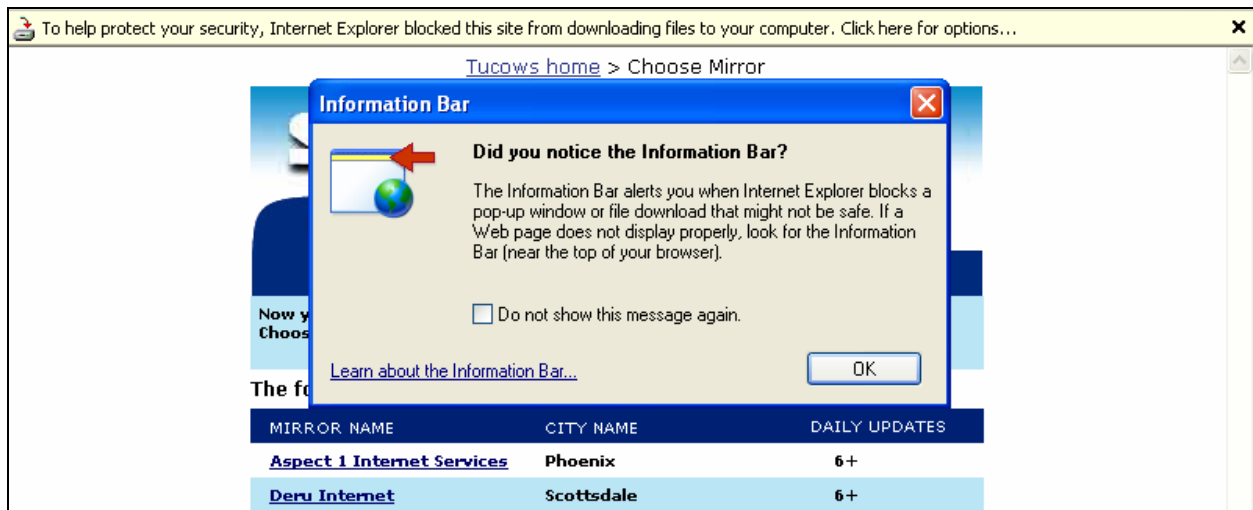


A new window with the Tucows address opens up.

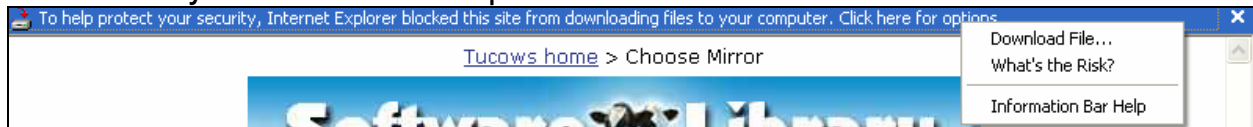
Click on the "Download Now" button.

Under U.S.A, choose any computer location, called a mirror site, where you can get the software. It really doesn't matter which one.

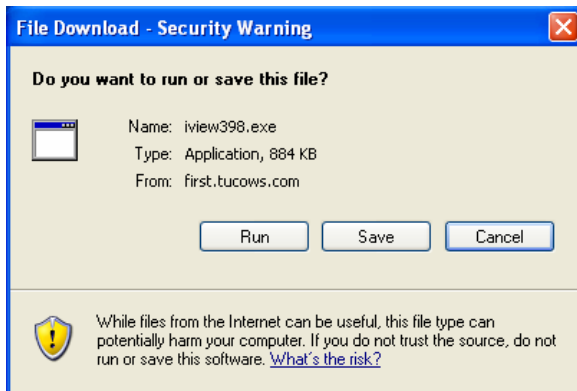
If you use Internet Explorer, you may see a gold bar across the screen. You may also get a message. The software won't automatically be downloaded.



Click the OK button to make the message go away. Click on the gold bar where it says "Click here for options..."

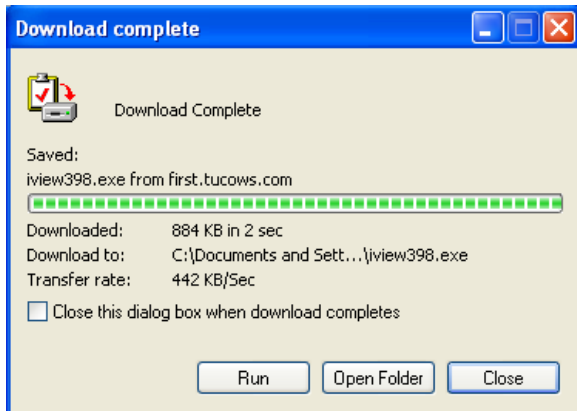


Notice that the entire gold bar turns blue. Click on "Download File..." Then go back and choose the mirror site again.



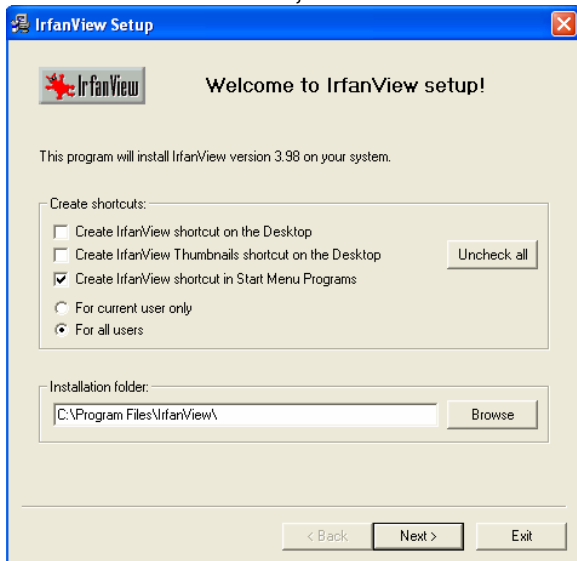
When you get the message, click on the Save button.
Choose to save it on your Desktop.
Click on the Save button.
The file should be downloaded to your computer.

You may see a message saying the download is complete.
Click on the Run button.



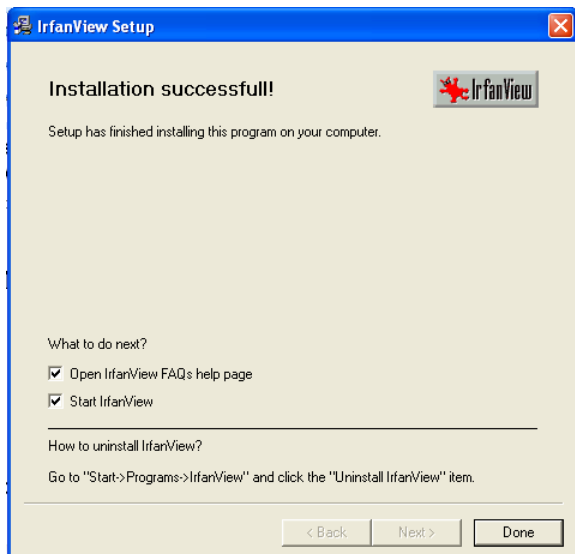
After you get the Security Warning, click the Run button with that message.

In the first screen, have the choice match this box.



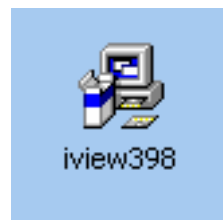
Click Next unless you want to read what is new in the latest version.
Choose None unless you want Windows to know that certain files should be opened by IrfanView. Click Next.

Choose to not install the Google Desktop Search bar unless you want it.
Click Next.
Click Next.



Click Done.

After making sure that IrfanView opens up and the help information is available, close both windows.



On the Desktop, delete the installation file.
Close the Internet Explorer windows.

To run IrfanView, find it in the start menu.
Use Start>All Programs>IrfanView>IrfanView.
