

Digital Footprint – Lesson Two

Grade Level: 9-12

Duration: One 15 minute session

Description: This program is designed to help students who are using the Internet to identify and avoid situations that could threaten their safety.

Content Outline:

1. Display Gina's Page found at <http://look2ways.com/education/lessons.htm#> and ask the following questions;

Gina's full name (See URL), Gina's city and state (and even what part of the city), what Gina looks like, Gina's age (18), names of her friends, the name of her school, and Gina's MyBook homepage.

2. Display Gina's Blog and ask what information is being exposed;

Her boyfriend is Jason, her family is going to Hawaii for 10 days (home empty on specific dates), and she owns a huge gamer setup 42" flat screen TV, xBox 360, new fast PC.

3. Display Gina's Friends' Comments and Photos page and ask what information is being exposed;

More photos to help identify Gina, what her sister looks like, Kylie is leaning on a car that shows the license plate number, house number in the background, more information on her friends.

4. Out of all of the information that is being displayed what would be of interest to a thief?

Her name, how recently she logged into the site, when her family will be away from home, items worth stealing.
