Problem Statement	The District's prior Long Range Facility Plan was completed in 2018. Since then, the District has completed \$199 million in capital bond project upgrades and the enrollment forecast has changed. The District needs to update the Long Range Facility Plan to reflect current conditions and future enrollment projections.
Meeting Frequency	The committee will meet 4-6 times between April and June 2025. Proposed meeting dates: April 16 April 30 May 14 May 28 June 4 (as needed) June 18 (as needed)
Procedures & Process	Meetings will be facilitated by Kim Patten, Director of Operations. The process used within the committee to make a recommendation shall be consensus. Committee meetings will be open to the public to observe. Written input from the public may be submitted to the Committee.
Plan Adoption	Because this is an update to the existing plan, it will not be formally adopted, rather submitted to the Superintendent for consideration.
Proposed Committee Members	 Committee members will represent a cross section of the school community as follows: Business Representative – 1 City of Corvallis Representative – 1 Benton County Representative – 1 Community Members, must be resident to school district boundary (At-Large) – 3 2018 Long Range Facilities Plan Committee Members – 2
