

## Can my student go to school?

# For students **NOT** up to date on their vaccination (2 primary doses, 14 days after last dose) \*

\* Students 18 and older require a booster shot to be up to date on their vaccination, if they are 5 months or more past their last dose



- NO symptoms
- NO COVID-19 diagnosis
- NO close contact with someone who tested POSITIVE for COVID-19





- NO symptoms
- NO COVID-19 diagnosis
- Close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19



- 1 or more symptoms for any duration
- NO close contact with someone who tested POSITIVE for COVID-19





- 1 or more symptoms for any duration
- Close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19



- Tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19
  - with or without symptoms



### OK TO GO TO SCHOOL



### CANNOT GO TO SCHOOL

Student must quarantine for a minimum of 5 days

Prior to returning, student must have a negative COVID-19 test

- Seek testing 3-5 days after close contact
- Student must continue to quarantine until they can present a negative test
- Report test results to the district nursing department or the school's main office
- If symptoms develop after student gets tested, follow flowchart for 1 or more symptoms

If student does not get tested prior to returning, they must continue to quarantine for a total of 10 days. They can return to school on day 11, as long as they don't have symptoms



### CANNOT GO TO SCHOOL

Student must stay home and seek testing immediately

Until further notice, the district requires ALL individuals with symptoms to have a negative test prior to returning to school

 Test can be a Binax rapid test at school, a PCR test at a local testing site, or an at-home test

Report test results to the district nursing department or the school's main office

Student will be able to return on the date set by the district nursing department **IF**:

- symptoms have significantly improved and are well-controlled without medication
- AND no new symptoms have developed



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Student must quarantine for a minimum of 5 days and seek testing immediately

Until further notice, the district requires **ALL individuals with symptoms to have a negative test** prior to returning to school

 Test can be a Binax rapid test at school, a PCR test at a local testing site, or an at-home test

Report test results to the district nursing department or the school's main office



### CANNOT GO TO SCHOOL

Student must isolate following current isolation guidance

The district nursing department will determine the student's isolation period with guidance from Benton County Health Department

Student will be able to return on the date set by the district nursing department **IF**:

- student is fever-free without fever-reducing medication for 24 hours
- AND symptoms have significantly improved and are well-controlled without medication

Student must be able to correctly and consistently wear a well-fitting mask for the remaining 5 days
