Date: April 18-19, 2020

Who: Students (8 and older) and parent chaperones; student needs to be accompanied by a chaperone

Cost: Student \$65.00, Parent Chaperone \$45.00, PE+ Members receive a \$5 discount per person (enter Promotional Code mentioned in email to members or become a member during registration).

This event is from 6:00 PM, Saturday, April 18, 2020 to 9:00 AM the next day and includes a guided night tour, an evening snack, building a model rocket for students (and launching it the next day), an Evergreen Theater movie, breakfast, and museum admission on Sunday. You will need to bring a sleeping bag and pad, pillow, change of clothes, toiletries, and a signed copy of the Evergreen Medical Release Form. (Note: no shower facilities.)
