Student Enrollment

The count of students enrolled in a school. The basis is the attending school as captured in 2021-22 First Period Cumulative ADM collection as reported by ODE in the Fall Membership Report. Students attending programs offered through Harding Center and College Hill, including those enrolled for college coursework, are counted as enrolled/attending their home high school. 2021-22 is the first year Corvallis Online has been reported as a separate school recognized by the Oregon Department of Education.

Student Race/Ethnicity

Federally reported student race/ethnicity as by attending school. The district allows students/guardians to self-identify in one or more categories. Federal reporting requires students to be counted only once in each category. To accommodate federal requirements, district data is "rolled up" to one category - all students identifying with any one option under "Hispanic/Latino" is counted solely in the Federal "Hispanic/Latino" category; and, all students choosing more than one option other than "Hispanic/Latino" are reported solely as "Multi-Racial." In cases where at least one student in a group is enrolled at the school, but the percentage would round to 0, we display "<1". Similarly, if the percentage would round to 100, but not every student in the school belongs to that group, we display ">99".

Program Participation

The data are suppressed when necessary: if the number of students in the denominator is less than ten then this indicator is suppressed with a '*'; when the percentage is less than 5 or greater than 95, we display "<5" and ">95", respectively.
