


Corvallis Math Team

What:

Faculty from the OSU Department of Mathematics will provide math competition prep sessions. Emphasis will be on problem solving techniques including an appreciation of multiple perspectives and approaches. The math team prep sessions will be led by Dr. Farid Bouya, OSU Mathematics Instructor, as well as OSU Math graduate students. Examples of topics include explorations in combinatorics (counting), probability, geometry, algebra, number theory and logic.

Who:

Corvallis students in grades 9 through 12 from <u>any school</u> are welcome to participate. Topics will be adjacent to, but not necessarily overlapping with, high school curriculum, so all students, regardless of grade and level of math background, are encouraged to participate!

Why:

Math competitions are an excellent way for students to improve problem-solving skills. Students will develop, or deepen, their curiosity and passion for mathematics in a supportive enrivonment. These sessions could be used as practice for the AMC 10 or AMC 12, and as a preview of the college-level Putnam Exam.
