- 1. Welcome and Member Updates/Community Feedback-Emily Valdez asked for updates from the board meeting. Received feedback from a College Hill family that even though their daughter won't attend next year, they are still happy about the renovations.
- 2. Bond Program Update-Kim Patten and Dale Kuykendall presented a progress report on key projects.
