Unit Pay	Extra-duty pay for concessions, chaperone duty, scorekeeping, timekeeping, judging, etc., is established at the rate of \$25/hour.
Medical training	Employees will be paid their pro-rated per diem rate for required medical trainings (e.g., First Aid, CPR, epinephrine, glucagon, glucometer, diastat, and tube feeding). Payment will be tracked by sign in sheets at each training and will occur in a timely manner.
Outdoor School	\$175 for each overnight stay
Staff Trainer	\$300/day
Training (attendee)	\$180/day

If a team makes it into playoffs an additional stipend is paid to the coaches participating in the playoffs, pro-rated at a weekly amount of the stipend. A week is considered Sunday-Saturday. The additional playoff stipend will be paid at a weekly amount, regardless of how many days during the week is played.
