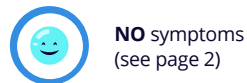


Can I go to work?

SYMPTOMS

- Cough
- Temperature of 100.4° or greater
- Chills
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Nasal congestion or runny nose
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea

➔ *A negative test is required prior to returning to school for students with this symptom*

CLOSE CONTACT

Close Contact includes anyone in one or more of the following categories:

- Been within 6 feet of a person with COVID-19 for a combined total of 15 minutes or more within a 24-hour period
- Live in the same household as a person with COVID-19
- Cared for a person with COVID-19
- Been in direct contact with saliva or other body secretions from a person with COVID-19 (for example: been coughed on, shared utensils, etc.)

In a K-12 indoor classroom setting, the close contact definition excludes students who were at least 3 feet away from an infected student when

- Both students were wearing face coverings/masks **AND**
- Other prevention strategies were in place

This exception does not apply to teachers, staff, or other adults in the indoor classroom setting.

COVID-19 TESTING

For staff who have had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, we recommend testing 5-7 days after close contact.

If you or someone in your household have any of the symptoms listed above, stay home and do one of the following:

- Contact your primary care provider (best option for continuity of care)

QUARANTINE

Staff who are fully immunized (14 days after last dose) **AND** do not have symptoms are not required to quarantine after close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19. If staff are showing any symptoms regardless of vaccination, please stay home and seek testing immediately. Report any symptoms to your building admin or supervisor.

For individuals who are required to quarantine, Benton County Health Department makes the final decisions about how long quarantine should last based on local conditions and needs. Please follow the recommendations of Benton County Health Department if you are required to quarantine.
