Bond Promises

Safety & Security Improvements

- Replace fire suppression and monitoring systems
- Improve seismic safety
- Replace access control system
- Replace emergency communication systems and emergency lighting

Modern Educational Spaces

 Renovate and expand classroom space for STEM and CTE

Renovations & Repairs

- Improve ADA accessibility
- Refurbish, repair, and weatherize building exteriors and roofs
- Upgrade infrastructure: electrical, heating, and plumbing systems
- Upgrade selected interior finishes & renovate locker room
- Renovate existing restrooms
- Addition and renovation to cafeterias




Overall Plan Upper level
