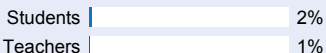

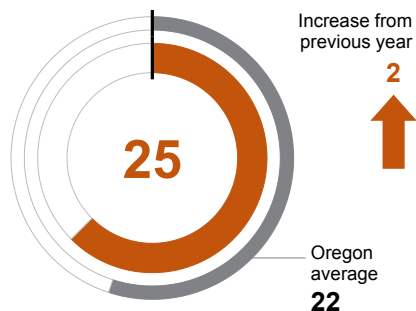

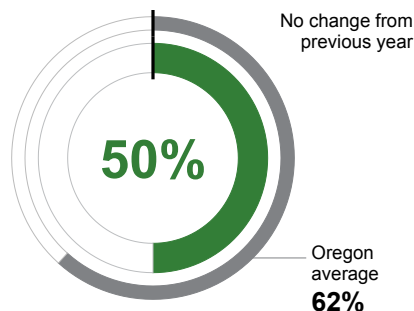
#### CLASS SIZE

#### REGULAR ATTENDERS

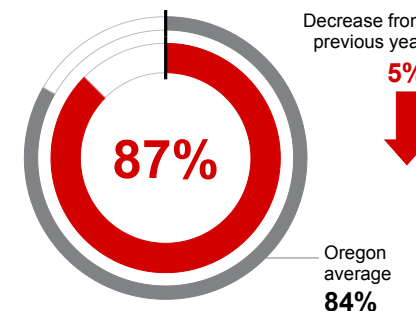

#### ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

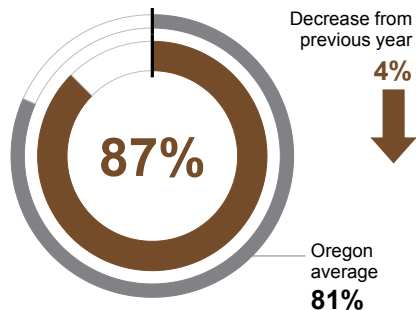
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

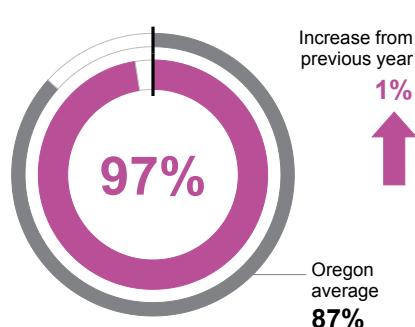
#### ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2018-19 graduating in 2021-22.



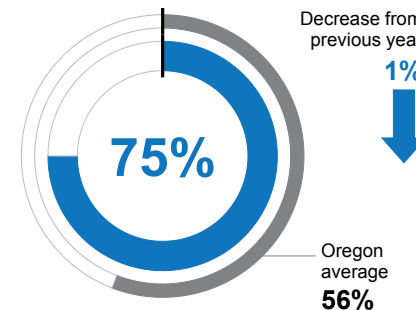
#### FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

### School Goals

Goal #1: All student groups will exceed 90% in terms of 9th grade on-track.

Goal #2: The graduation rate for students navigating poverty, Hispanic students, and students with disabilities will exceed 90%. Our Health 1 and Spartan Success class for all 9th graders as well as targeted intervention classes, supported Algebra 1 classes, and weekly advisor class and academic seminar time support goal number one. Summer School, AVID, CHS Prep classes, after-school tutoring, a dedicated Student Success Coach, and extension time support goal two.

### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

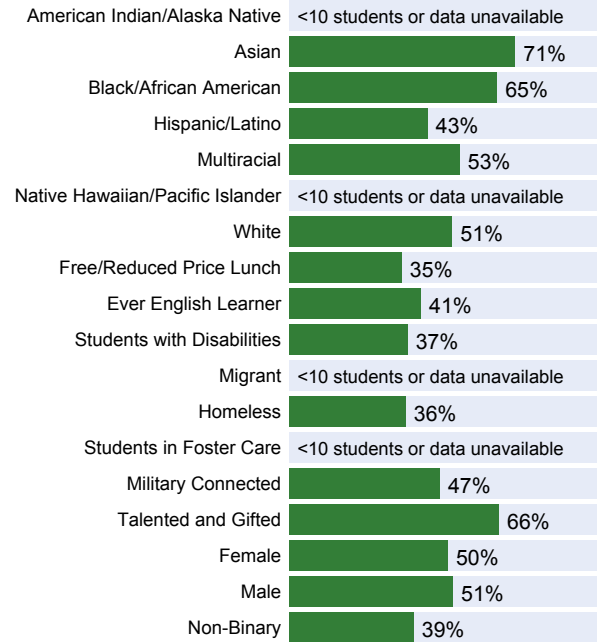

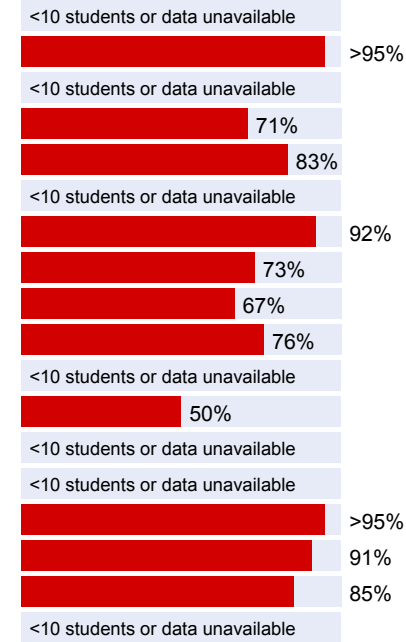

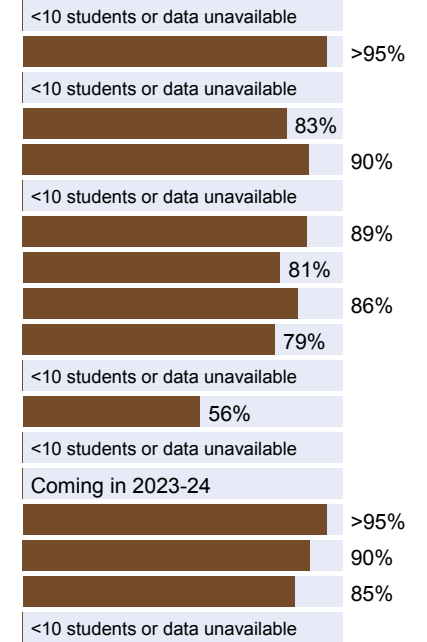
