




School Goals

Goal #1: All student groups will exceed 90% in terms of 9th

Goal #2: The graduation rate for students navigating poverty. Hispanic students, and students with disabilities will exceed 90%. Our Health 1 and Spartan Success class for all 9th graders as well as targeted intervention classes, supported Algebra 1 classes, and weekly advisor class and academic seminar time support goal number one. Students earning a high school diploma or GED within five years. Cohort Includes students who were firsttime ninth graders in 2017-18 finishing in 2021-22.




State Goals







