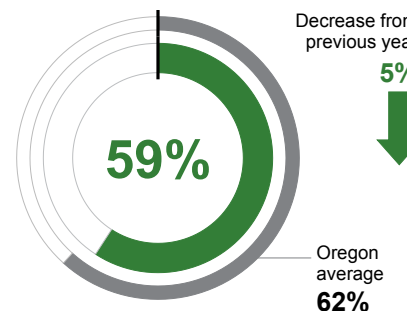

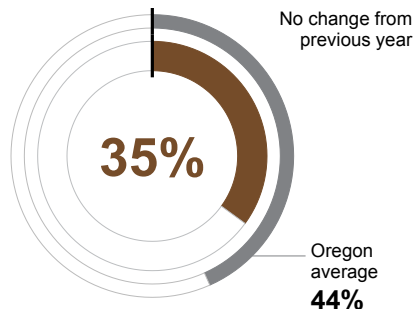

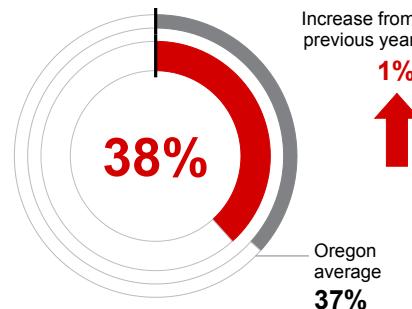

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



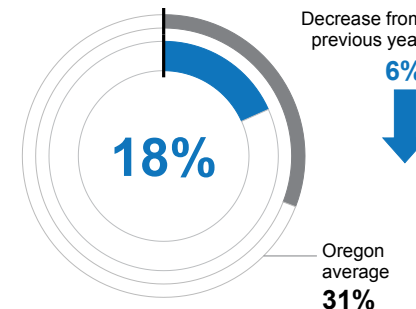
MATHEMATICS

School Goals

Our school is a positive and caring school community that puts student growth first.

We believe all students can learn and succeed at high levels, and we base our instruction on a balanced and comprehensive curriculum. We recognize the importance of foundational skills in reading, writing and math instruction, and we work hard to provide meaningful and integrated learning experiences in all content areas.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

We continuously encourage students to make positive behavior choices by implementing Positive Behavior Intervention and Support (PBIS).

PBIS is a system designed to explicitly teach safety, respect, and responsibility at our school, and celebrate positive behavior. Through instruction and regular practice, all staff members implement a consistent set of behavior expectations. When some students respond in unexpected ways, we make it an opportunity for re-teaching and learning.

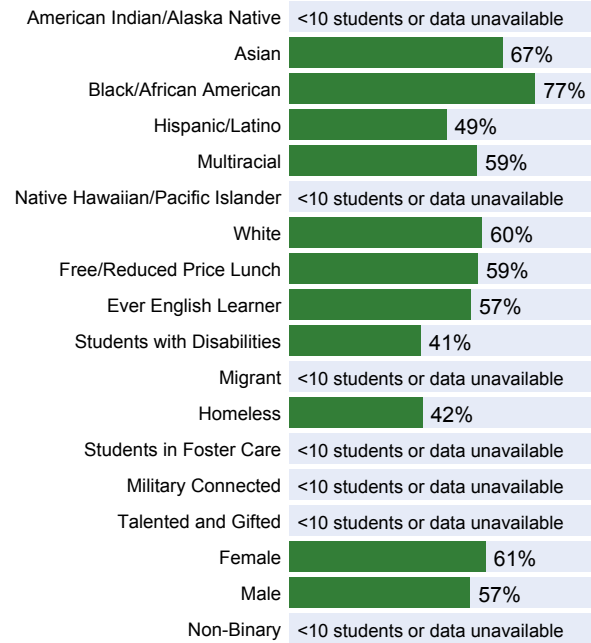

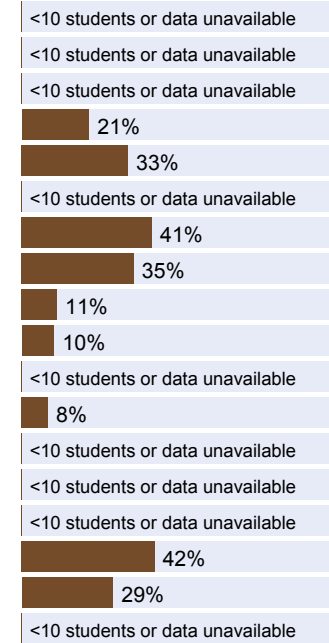

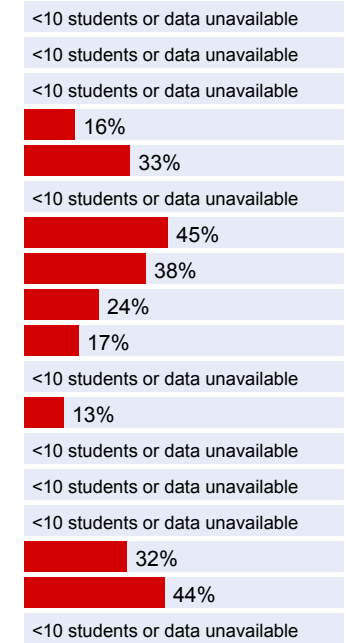

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

Corvallis schools are committed to providing a safe and positive learning environment for all students. We teach our students to celebrate diverse identities and "recognize, refuse, and report" bullying behaviors. We build social skills through a program called Caring School Community and our team quickly responds to reports of bullying/harassment. Programs our school has implemented include:
