Red	'Must-do' Capital Improvements Refer to 2017 update facility observation report for immediate need repairs.
Yellow	New School New (3) section elementary school assuming 494 students
Purple	Gymnasium Build new gymnasium facilities at school sites where separate gym/cafeteria facilities do not currently exist.
Purple	Permanent Building Additions (K-5 Configuration) 1 New Elementary School Provide permanent classroom space for all general instruction and special program space, i.e. art, music, early learning, SpEd, Resource, Computer Lab, etc. with in a Kinder thru 5th grade frame work, plus 1 replacement elementary schools.
Purple	Permanent Building Additions (K-5 Configuration) 2 New Elementary Schools Provide permanent classroom space for all general instruction and special program space, i.e. art, music, early learning, SpEd, Resource, Computer Lab, etc. with in a Kinder thru 5th grade frame work. Plus two new elementary schools.
Purple	Permanent Building Additions (K-4 Configuration) Provide permanent classroom space for all general instruction and special program space, i.e. art, music, early learning, SpEd, Resource, Computer Lab, etc. with in a Kinder thru 4th grade frame work. Expand existing middle school sites to 5th-6th and 7th-8th grade configurations. Expand to
Blue	Building Renovations (Major Renovation/Reconfigure) Interior renovations to include possible moving interior walls, providing new lighting, HVAC, electrical etc., as well as all interior finishes, i.e. wall coverings, flooring, ceilings, etc.
Blue	Building Refresh (Light Renovation) Lightly renovating existing spaces, i.e. replacing interior finishes such as flooring, wall finishes/paint, wall coverings, ceiling tile as needed.
Blue	Office-Security Upgrades Expanding existing office/admin areas to include controlled building entries, may include relocating walls, adding doors, and redirecting circulation.
Yellow	Collaboration Spaces Creating alcoves and niches for small group pull out areas, renovating larger spaces for small group instruction, and/or renovating and/or adding space for learning/socialization commons.
Yellow	Team Teaching Creating connection between adjacent classrooms with large double-door passage ways, small moveable walls, or creating openings.
Yellow	Visible Learning Replacing classroom entry doors with new door panels and interior side lights for vision between corridors and classroom spaces.
Yellow	Student & Family Support Providing approximately 1000 SQF or either renovated or new space for student services, community services, and/or community use.
Red	Infrastructure & Power Replacing and/or upgrading electrical service to underserved facilities to allow for increased technology use.
Yellow	Furniture District funded grant based furniture program assessible to all sites per application basis.
Green	Covered Play Shelters Providing exterior covered play shelters where none exist or are displaced by new classroom room construction, approx. 3000 SQF at elementary sites. And covered outdoor work areas for CTE programs at the secondary level, approximately 3500 SQF
Green	Site Improvements / Vehicular Circulation Reconfiguring drive isles, bus drop off routes, parking, and parent drop off lanes to ease congestion and improve both site circulation and safety
Green	Outdoor Learning / Garden Providing starter funds to assist parent/teacher organizations in installing outdoor learning facilities or teaching gardens.
Yellow	CTE Improvements Renovating CTE instructional spaces to provide safer working areas, improved infrastructure and technology/computer lab adjacencies.
