



Safety iPass Instructions for Parents/Guardians of K-5 Students

You will receive an email each school day from CrisisGo for each school student in your family. You also have the option to download the free mobile app on your smartphone or tablet (iOS or Android) if you prefer (CrisisGo). Either way, you will be able to complete the health screening to confirm your child's health status.

Steps for Completing the Health Screening using the Safety iPass Email

STEP 1: Open the email from CrisisGo

- If you did not receive the daily email, check your Spam folder and mark them as not spam.
- The email will also include a link with information about the Safety iPass app

For the health and safety of students and staff, we have implemented an online health screening process for all students attending school on-site.

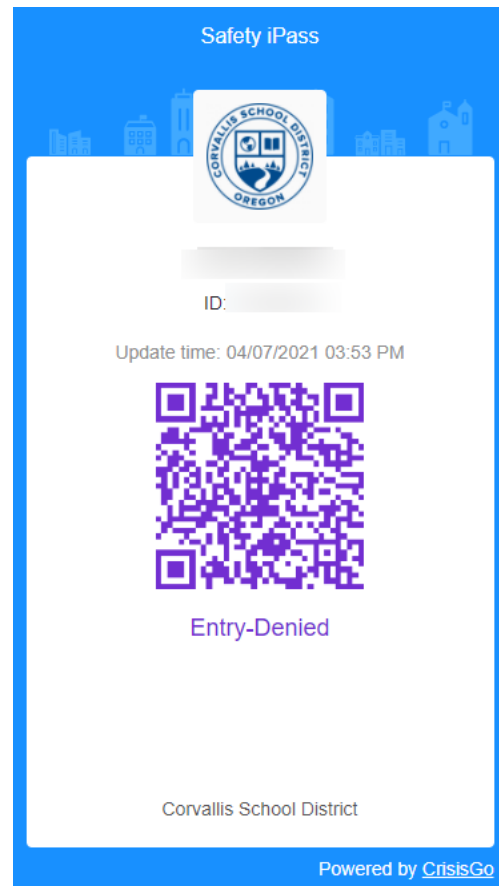
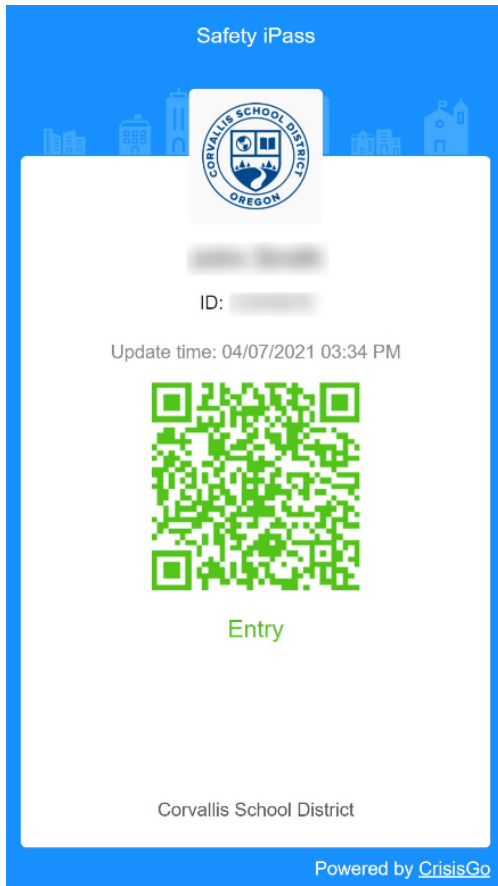
STEP 2: Click the blue REPORT button

- A web window will open on the CrisisGo Safety iPass page.
- You may select your preferred language from the dropdown menu in the upper right corner. You only need to do this one time. All following health screening forms will be in your preferred language.
- The page will show your child's name and student ID number and questions about your child's health status.

STEP 3: Read the questions carefully and select your answers

STEP 4: Click NEXT

- If your child has no symptoms, their health status will display GREEN when they check in at school.
- If your child has symptoms, their health status will display PURPLE. You should keep your child home from school and contact the school office.



When Students Arrive at School

Students will enter school at a designated entry

- School staff will check your student in at school and will scan the student QR code.*
- If the student QR status is GREEN, the student will proceed to class.
- If the student health screening has not been completed by the parent or guardian the staff member will complete the screening
- If the student QR status is PURPLE, the student will be accompanied to the health room or remain outside and parents/guardians will be contacted to pick up their child.

*Unlike middle and high school students, your K-5 student does not need to present an ID card or device with their QR code. Staff at elementary schools will have a roster of K-5 student QR codes for checking students in.
