

# The World Peace Game

## June 15-19, 2020 • Teachers Master Class

### What is the World Peace Game?

The World Peace Game is a dynamic, hands-on political simulation that gives children the opportunity to explore the connectedness of the global community through the lens of the economic, social, and environmental crises. Each child takes on the role of prime minister, UN officials, World Bank members, arms dealers and more. The goal of the Game is to achieve world peace and global prosperity by solving 50 interlocking crisis that emulates the experience of governing nations, past and present.

### What is a World Peace Game Master Class?

Master class participants observe trainers facilitating the Game live with students each morning. Afternoon sessions focus on introducing educators to the following:

- Guiding philosophy and pedagogical principles that underlie the Game.
- Identifying the essential attributes necessary to facilitate the Game through a series of reflective questions and activities.
- Designing learning that is inspired by the principles and spirit of the Game.

The five-day class certifies educators to use the World Peace Game in their classrooms.
